**COPYRIGHT INSTRUCTIONS FOR EDUCATIONAL RESOURCES OFFERED
BY THE ELLEN MACARTHUR FOUNDATION**

As part of our educational work at the Ellen MacArthur Foundation to inspire a generation to rethink and redesign the future, we have outlined below our approach to the use, sharing and dissemination of our educational content by our educational partners. If you require any further information or clarification, please contact info@ellenmacarthurfoundation.org.

All educational content generated or commissioned by EMF or any associated organisation ("**EMF**") is protected by copyright. Copyright protects the use of EMF's work, which is essential to enable it to further its charitable objects. The use of materials, such as that content, by EMF's highly valued educational partners is also essential to the learning and dissemination process to accelerate the transition to a circular economy. EMF is providing its educational content on the basis you will respect EMF's rights in that content, including under copyright and other intellectual property law.

You **may**:

- use;
- adapt and/or
- copy,

the educational content provided to you by EMF **only** for educational or personal use, to further EMF's charitable objects i.e. to accelerate the transition to a circular economy.

To help EMF protect its copyright in that content, you **must** acknowledge that EMF is the source of it by ensuring that a copyright notice in the relevant form set out below (intact and unamended) is marked on any adaptations or copies of all, or part, of that content. This would include marking that copyright notice on all documents or materials produced by you, which reference that content.

You **must not**:

- use the educational content provided to you by EMF in any commercial way or commercially exploit it in any way;
- use that content for any illegal purpose;
- use that content for any purpose other than to pursue a circular economy;
- licence that content;
- sell that content;
- rent that content;
- lease that content; and/or
- assign or transfer your rights in that content.

Long form copyright notice

Where all or a material part of textual EMF educational content (i.e. a paragraph or more) is used, or included within your own content (either copied verbatim or amended to any extent), the following notice should be placed as a footnote immediately below your relevant content.

All rights reserved save only that permission granted to adapt or copy for educational or personal use, to further the charitable objects of Ellen MacArthur Foundation. In all cases this notice must remain intact and unamended to acknowledge Ellen MacArthur Foundation as the source. Licencing, selling, renting, leasing, transferring, assigning or otherwise commercially exploiting is strictly prohibited."*

Short form copyright notice

Where graphical EMF content (such as diagrams, photographs, charts or tables) is used, or included within your own content (either copied verbatim or amended to any extent), the following notice should be placed immediately below your relevant content.

*"Copyright © Ellen MacArthur Foundation [**Note: insert year of publication**]."*
